4 次の英文は、ユカ(Yuka)がウォルトディズニー(Walt Disney)について発表した英文です。これを読んで、あとの(1)~(3)に答えなさい。*印の語句にはスピーチのあとに(注)があります。((21点)

When Walt Disney was a boy he liked to *draw pictures. As he grew older, he wrote many different kinds of stories. When he started making movies his first *main *character was called *Mortimer Mouse. The first two movies had no music that *matched the *action, so they were not *successful. Disney added music to match the action of the characters in his third movie. It was the first of his many *successes.

Some people thought that Mortimer was not a very good name for the character. The name *Mickey was much better, they said. Disney changed the name. It is true that the name Mickey Mouse is now famous all over the world, and may be the most famous *cartoon character ever.

Walt Disney became famous for making movies and then he *created *Disneyland. He produced cartoons with his own characters and also used famous stories from the past. He later made movies about animals and he won many *awards for his work. He has the *record for winning the most *Academy Awards. Twenty-two!

But Disneyland was the biggest success of his life. People all over the world have visited there. We should be *thankful to Walt Disney for bringing such fun and *entertainment into our lives.

My mother is a *nurse. She always takes care of me when I am sick. Last month I had a cold and I felt really bad, so my mother took the day off work and stayed with me. She gave me medicine and said, "Karen, you must rest a lot, and drink a lot of water."

"Why do people get colds?" I asked her, and she told me that there are many kinds of cold *viruses out there. You never know which one you will get, so there isn't a *cure for each one. "When a virus *attacks your body, your body works hard to fight it," she said. "You may feel bad, but your body is doing everything it can to kill the cold."

When I was back at school a few days later I borrowed a book from the library. It was all about colds and *flus. The book said that different people around the world have different ways to help people who have colds. In the United States and some other countries, people eat *chicken soup to feel better. Some people take hot baths and warm drinks. Other people take medicines they get in the *drugstore.

There was <u>one interesting thing</u> I saw in the book. Some scientists say that you should not take medicines when you have a cold. Bodies can do a great job on their own, they just need time.

Another interesting thing I read about is this: "It takes about one week to *get over a cold if you don't take medicine," the book said, "but only seven days to get over a cold if you take it."
